

Mission Outreach in Kuressaare / Saaremaa July 2012

In July (12th-19th) a group of young people from Lüdenscheid and Berlin were in Estonia, island Saaremaa. They came to serve the local youth in a Christian youth camp and later to do street evangelism in downtown Kuressaare.

We had a great time in the youth camp (July 12th-15th). There was all kind of fun activities and also teaching from God's word and worship time. The biggest highlights were Friday and Saturday evening when there was freedom for the Holy Spirit to move. We took lots of time to pray for each other. God was healing souls and bodies while we were soaking in His presence.

July 17th-19th we took to street evangelism in Kuressaare. Every morning young people from Kuressaare and the team from Germany gathered in the garden of a hostel. We worshiped God and prayed for His guidance and blessing for the day. Then we went out to the streets in small groups. All day long the Holy Spirit gave us many ideas how to serve the people of Kuressaare.

For example: One of us bought flowers and went to a waitress, gave her the flowers and said, "This is a gift from God to You and God loves you". She was deeply touched and God's love was poured into her heart.

Another example: One of us got a weird sentence in his mind, "God wants to go hiking with you!" He went up to one woman and told her that. Right away the woman answered, "But my legs are hurting". So they had a chance to pray for her legs. The woman's legs were healed and she also gave her life to Jesus.

These things happened every day. God was lifted up and He showed miracles and love through the actions of His children. It was good practice and encouragement, also for the youth in Kuressaare! We saw how simply God can do His work through the ones who obey Him. God is good!
