She said yes, so I prayed. After the prayer I went to say hi to her little daughter because she was looking at me from the baby – carriage. The next day we did Treasure hunting again. I wrote all the thoughts in my head on a piece of paper, again, and I joined a group. In the part of the paper where I was supposed to write some name, I was very unsure. I had the name Tom in my head but I was almost 100 percent sure that it is not from God. So we went to find some treausures and after almost 10 metres we found an old man. He was standing next to a yellow house, next to a church, in a park and he had a yellow t-shirt. And that was all on our descriptions. He coudln't walk alone so he was using a machine that was helping him to walk which was on a paper of one of the members of the group. He was very open and happy that he could talk to us. So we prayed for him and he came to our program in the evening.

And the man was just smiling, with tears in his eyes and he couldn't believe it. It was a very strong moment.

The third day we went to find some treasures again. But this time, it was harder. We were walking all around town for a very long time and we couldn't find anything that would be on our lists. But after almost 30 minutes of walking I noticed a yellow house and a blue tent next
